## 3. TRANSPORTATION



At arrival and departure, the HOC will ensure transportation for all delegations and officials from Poznan Ławica Airport (POZ) to the Hotel and from the Hotel to the Airport.

During competition the HOC will ensure transportation on the route Hotel -Venue-Hotel. Detailed schedule of transportation will be available in the hotel lobby and the information desk at the venue.

## PARKING INFORMATION (for team's cars, pick-ups and buses)

Due to unforeseen reasons for the HOC, all delegations need to leave the main parking on September 8th (after 11:00 a.m.), move their vehicles to a temporary parking for one day, and then to come back to the main parking. We advise to act as follow: on September 8th to remove vehicles from the main parking to the Event Venue and then after the games to go to the temporary parking and leave them there for a night. 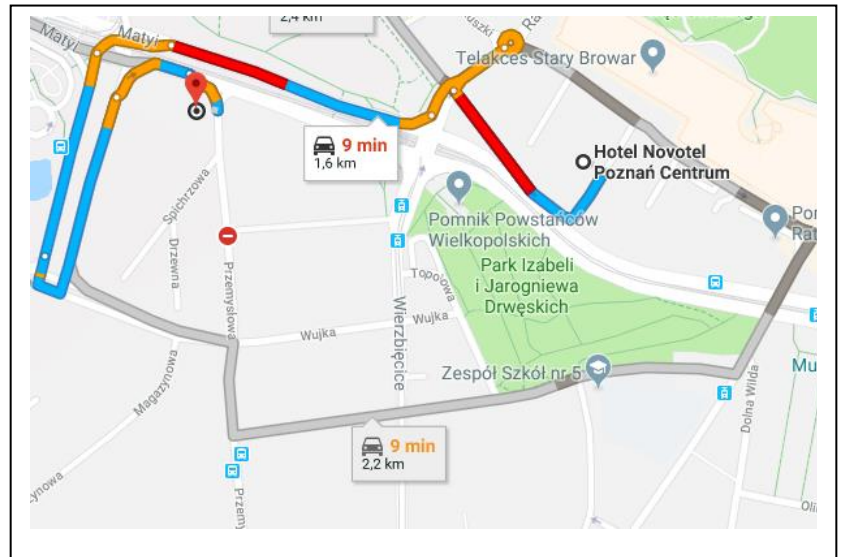

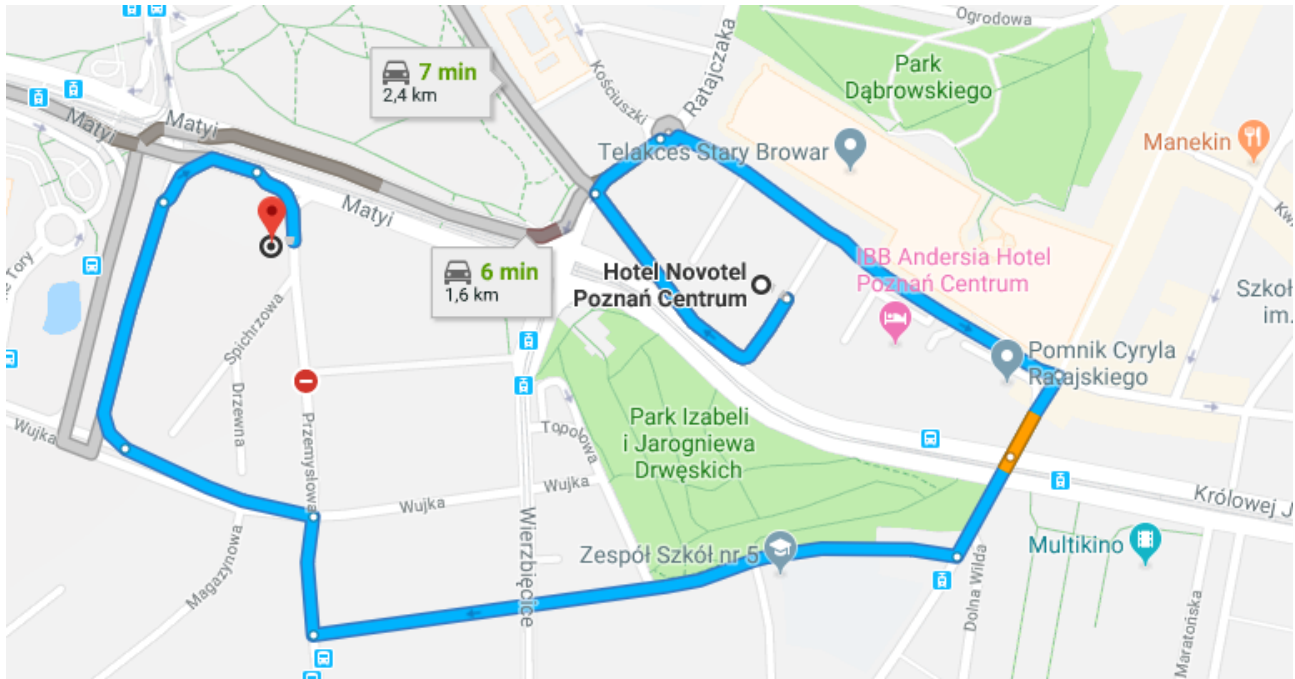

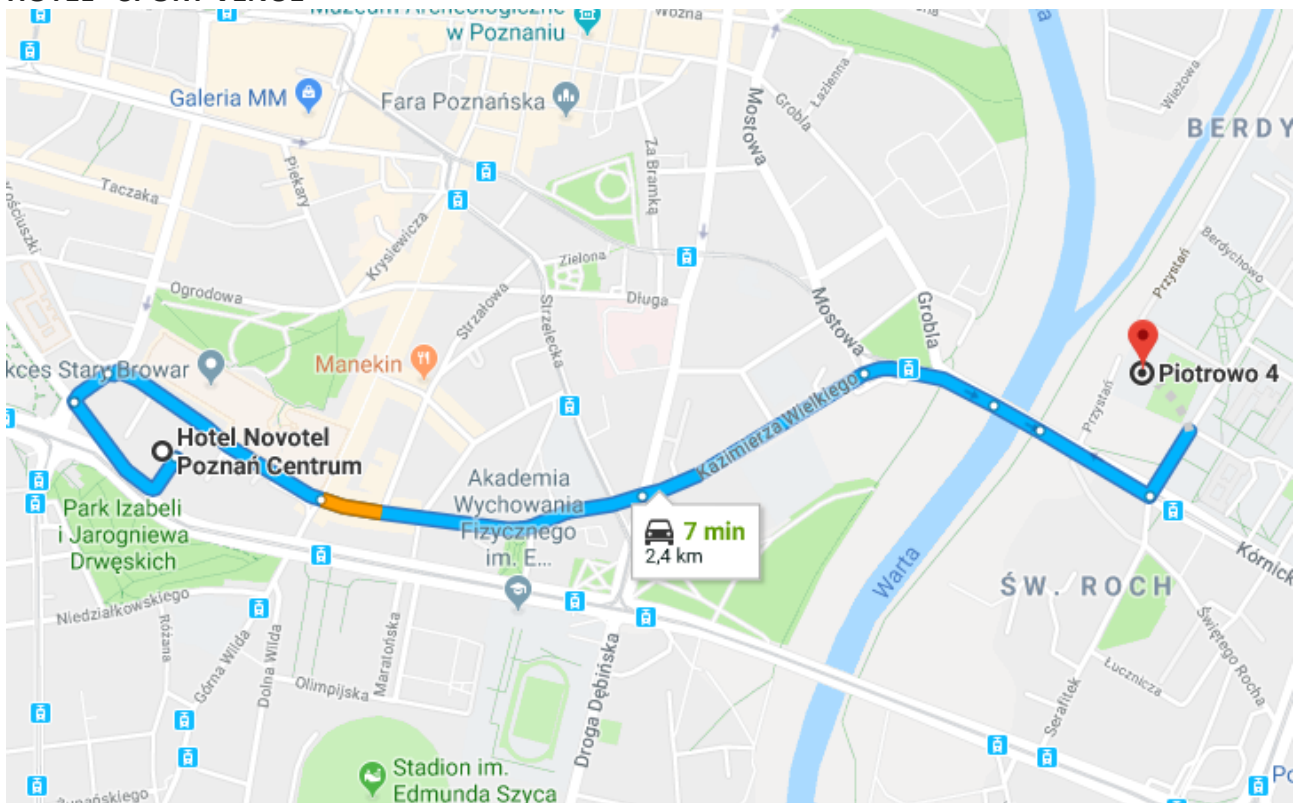

## 12. CLASSIFICATION

Athletes which will be classified, must bring their Passport (or Identification Card) to their classification appointment.

In addition, the athletes must sign, in the presence of a witness, the BISFed Consent for Classification Form (all teams received it by email).

Please ensure that the athletes understand the document, provide translation if necessary and bring the form to classification.

Athletes must bring a list of all medications and any pertinent health information written in English with them. They must also bring the Certificate of Diagnosis completed by their medical doctor (all teams received it by email).

The athlete must come to classification with Boccia equipment used in play and be dressed in sports clothing. If they are not properly attired they will not be classified.

## 13. SPORTS EQUIPMENT & SPORTS EQUIPMENT CHECK

Athletes may use their own Sports Equipment. Sports Equipment includes:

- Balls
- Chairs (BC1,BC2,BC4)



- Ramps
- Communication devices to be used in F.O.P.
- Gloves or splints

Prior to the competition commencing, all Sports Equipment will be checked and certified by selected referees and supervised by the Head Referee.

Equipment that does not meet the criteria will not be certified and will be held by the organization until the end of the championship.

At any time, including during a match, the referee may confirm the eligibility of any piece of equipment. Any equipment that fails eligibility during competition will be confiscated for the remainder of the competition; details of this offence will be published at the Information Desk.

## 14. TRAINING SCHEDULE

The teams must be at the entrance of the competition area at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time.

Five minutes before the finish time they must stop training and prepare all the equipment to get out at the scheduled time.

Access to the entrance of the training area will be allowed only to accredited staff or athletes who are scheduled for training.

## 15. WARM-UP AREA PROCEDURES

Warm-up area will be located in the sport venue (on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floor)

Warm-up for the first row of matches of each competition day will be at the F.O.P.

Priority will be given to competitors playing on the next row of matches.

Players may be accompanied into the Warm-up area by a maximum number of people as follows:

BC1	1 coach, 1 assistant
BC2	1 coach, 1 assistant
BC3	1 coach, 1 assistant
BC4	1 coach, 1 assistant
BC3 Pairs	1 coach, 1 assistant per athlete
BC4 Pairs	1 coach, 1 assistant
BC1/BC2 Teams	1 coach, 1 assistant

If it is necessary, one translator and one physiotherapist/massage therapist per Country may enter the Warm Up area. They can't help or assist with coaching.



## 16. CALL ROOM PROCEDURES

Call Room procedures are documented in the BISFed 2017 Competition Rules V2: ([http://www.bisfed.com/wp-content/uploads/2017/03/Final\\_BISFed-2017-Competition-Rules-V2.pdf](http://www.bisfed.com/wp-content/uploads/2017/03/Final_BISFed-2017-Competition-Rules-V2.pdf)).

In case of doubt or any disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the English version shall prevail.

Prior to entering the Warm-up Area and Call Room, Athletes, Coaches and Sport Assistants must ensure that they have their Accreditation Tag with them. Athlete competitor numbers should be clearly visible. Failure to do will result in refused entry to the Call Room.

PLEASE BE AWARE YOU'LL NEED ABOUT 10-15 MINUTES TO REACH THE CALL ROOM AREA FROM THE WARM UP ZONE.



## 17. BOCCIA BALLS

The Organizing Committee will have Competition Balls available for both training and competition.

Athletes personal sets of Boccia Balls will be checked as Sports Equipment in the manner set out above.



Immediately outside the entrance to the Call Room will be an electronic set of weighting scales and measuring template for Sides to check the eligibility of their balls before entry.

During the competition, random ball checks will take place in the Call Room prior to each round of matches with one or two courts being selected for inspection. Balls that fail the criteria will be confiscated until the end of the competition (as above).

The player will be allowed to replace the ball/s with competition ball/s at this time. After the match, these competition balls shall be returned to the Referee.



## 18. PROTEST PROCEDURES

## 19. IMPORTANT LOCATIONS

### Access to Restricted Areas

Access to restricted areas shall be limited to authorised personnel only and in accordance with the BISFed International Boccia Rules. Authorised personnel shall only be granted access if they are wearing their appropriate Accreditation Card in a visible place. Full details of restricted areas shall be explained at the Technical Meeting.



## 20. CEREMONIES

The Opening Ceremony will take place in the Sport Venue on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> September, 15:00.

Medals ceremonies will take place **on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> September (individual) and on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> September (pairs&teams)**, after the games.

The Closing Party will take place at the building next to the venue.

## 21. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

All doping procedures will be in accordance to the procedures of the WADA.

The doping control tests will be conducted by Polish Anti-Doping which is a WADA member.

BISFed Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) forms are accessible on the BISFed website. ## 22. MEDICAL CARE

Medical care will be provided in the Sport Venue during whole the competition.
